## 5,059 teens went to camp



Of the 413 campers who attended this outreach camp in Nyamata, Rwanda, 23 of them were Muslim. Here is a small testimony from one of these campers: "I come from a Muslim family, so they were very upset when they found out that I was attending Young Life. My parents made it very clear that they would not accept me if I became a Christian. Because of this, they did not want me to go to camp and asked me to stop attending Young Life entirely. I was very saddened by this, but since they had seen the positive influence the leaders were able to have on my life, they reluctantly allowed me to continue going to Young Life and even said yes to camp. Camp was amazing! I made so many new friends and learned about the transformative power of Christ's love. Thanks to Young Life I decided to give my life to Jesus Christ and now know that no matter how impossible it may seem, my parents too can accept Christ into their lives."







### **RWANDA YOUNGLIVES**

In April, leaders hosted a three-day Young Lives camp in Kilgali, the capital city of Rwanda. It was incredible to hear the testimonies of these mothers about how they first got pregnant and what they have learned since then. The camp speaker was a teen mom herself and was able to share her story of how she came to Christ after having her baby and how she is now married with three kids, one of which is the child she had as a teenager. All of the teen moms were inspired by her transformational story, as they feared not finding a husband due to their early pregnancies. Of the 43 moms at camp, 14 of them came to accept Jesus into their lives. Please join us in prayer as we seek to reach more teen moms and share the gospel with them.
