20,301 TEENS WENT TO CAMP

LIBERIA OUTREACH CAMP

At this camp, over 240 kids from Montserrado County, Liberia received the welcome of a lifetime. A marching band and songs ushered them in, making these kids feel like kings and queens. Amazingly, 93 kids gave their lives to Christ! Morgan was one of those kids. He comes from a neighborhood plagued by drug and alcohol abuse, and where prostitution is a common practice. Morgan sold drugs, and despite multiple arrests, refused to turn away from his lifestyle. Then, Morgan met Frank, a local Young Life leader. Despite Morgan's decision to sell drugs at a Young Life camp (which resulted in him being sent home), Frank continued to faithfully walk beside Morgan as his Young Life leader. He never gave up on Morgan, and invited him to camp for a second time. This time, Morgan gave his life to Christ. He now feels convicted to share the gospel with the kids who used to buy drugs from him. Praise God for this powerful transformation and join us in praying that He will use Morgan as a vessel of love and hope within his community!

SIERRA LEONE OUTREACH CAMP

Amina comes from a Muslim family and had never heard the story of Jesus before. At the end of camp, Amina shared her testimony. "I thank God that Young Life has opened our eyes to know the truth about Jesus...I am a Muslim, and my parents are too, but today I have given myself to Jesus. My challenge is my parents, but I pray that when I confront them with this, they will agree and allow me to follow my own desire. Praise be to God."
