4,269 teens went to camp



For three days there was an outreach camp in Gwanda, a mid-sized town just southeast of Bulawayo, Zimbabwe's second largest city. In this short time, 204 of the 310 campers committed their lives to Christ. Sixteen-year-old Jaya reflected on her three days at camp very fondly. "Before coming to camp, I didn't allow myself time to connect with God. I lived my life ignoring the law that God has set before us and treated people very poorly. Then I got invited to come to Young Life camp. I loved the atmosphere at camp! The food was delicious and the assignment team was hilarious. Most importantly, the messages shared with us changed the way I understood the gospel. Cabin time was super helpful for me, as I was able to share and process what I was learning. It was here that I decided to receive Jesus as my Lord and personal Savior. I pray that I am able to grow spiritually as I head home and that I am able to share the Good News with my family and friends."

"Formerly, knowing God, reading and understanding His Word was not of importance to me. Alcoholism was the major problem in my life. Furthermore, because of the desires of my flesh, I did not take into consideration that sleeping around with different women and girls was just pushing me away from God. At camp, I came to the realization that these things create a rift between God and I. In a nutshell, camp has transformed me and brought me closer to God. I will therefore pray more in Jesus Christ and invite and encourage other young people to have more time in God." - Nicolas
