

In the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), we've had our share of ups and downs this past year. Many difficult circumstances have affected our families, ministries, and our country, including a resurgence of militia groups, outbreaks of Ebola and Cholera, terrible flooding, and worst of all COVID-19.

Though the year was full of uncertainties, we managed to host 21 out of the 26 camps that were planned, before COVID-19 shut in-person ministry down. More than 4,000 kids went to camp and almost half of them gave their lives to Christ.

Currently, more than 4,500 kids have been reached through phone and video calls, and many have given their lives to Christ. Through it all, we give Glory to God as we continue to do ministry through online platforms.

RWANDA OUTREACH CAMP

Rwanda hosted a very unique outreach camp before COVID-19 hit. Leaders put on this particular camp once a year, referred to as the "Young Life Festival" and is essentially a very large talent show! Kids come from all over Kigali to watch dance, singing, comedy and even a fashion show. Young Life staff and leaders invite different famous gospel singers in Rwanda to help judge the competition. This year the talent was outrageous! All the campers came very well prepared and the crowd was made up of 275 kids! One person goes home with a grand prize. Throughout the night, the Young Life program team does skits in-between talents and at the end, the gospel message is shared. Kids are sitting at the edge of their seat so ready to hear this message. This year, 118 kids were saved! Most of the kids who got saved were those who came to the festival to just have fun. After the event, staff and leaders had a meeting with the 118 who accepted Jesus to help them to know the way forward in their new decision to follow Christ.

DRC TEAM LEADERS MEETING

Young Life DRC held a day-long meeting with a small group of team leaders. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the vision of the new ministry in the neighborhood of Kinshasa.
