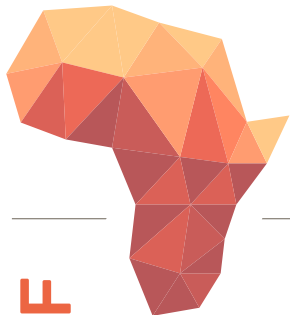

The incredible leaders pay for them to take showers, and they also bring bread for them to share each week. Attending camp for these kids was an unforgettable experience. Local churches and leaders donated clothes and shoes that they got to take back home. 74 kids left this camp with a new faith and trust in Jesus!
