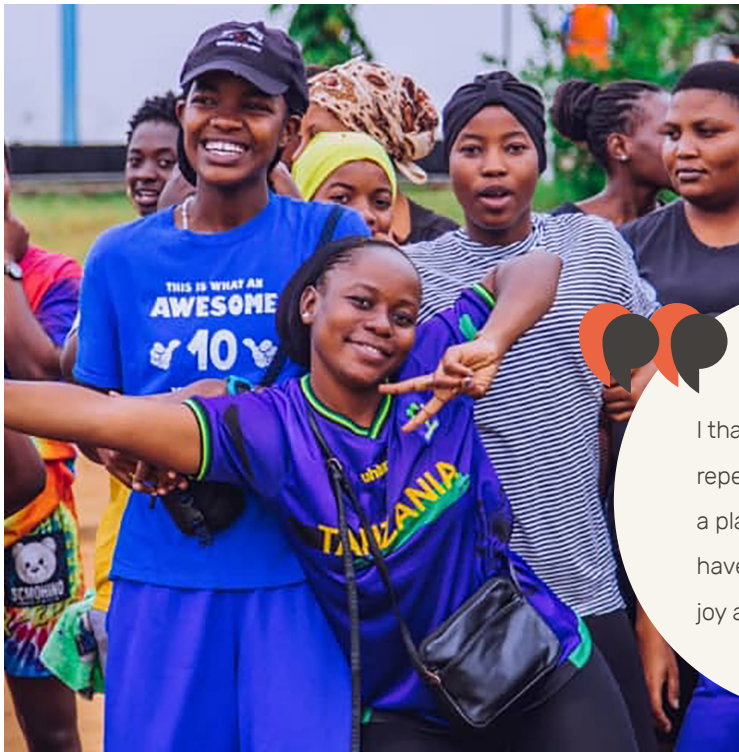

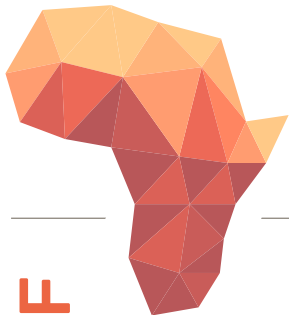

Zanzibar Day Camp

Omar's father died when he was young, leaving him and his two siblings under the sole care of their widowed mother, who struggled to provide for them. Omar dropped out of school to work and help his family. This summer he attended Young Life camp where he experienced true rest and felt hopeful. Tanzania Outreach Camp



David discovered the hope of Jesus during one of the darkest seasons of his life. As Covid-19 surged, heavy rainfall destroyed his family's home, leaving them with nowhere to go. David's family found shelter inside a high school, where they lived in classrooms alongside other displaced families. There, he encountered Young Life leaders who hosted weekly Young Life clubs. This brought hope to David despite his family's incredible loss. At Young Life, they danced, sang and learned about God together. Eventually his leader invited him to camp, where he heard the gospel and, alongside 83 other teenagers, gave his life to Christ.
