Rwanda: We recently had our Festivals (Day Camps). Please pray for all the kids who gave their lives to Christ and the leaders committed to following up with them. Pray for Patrick who came back from HOT to be able to catch up with his studies.

Mozambique: We are asking God for new places where we can have clubs. We are also praying that our partnership with the Acacone association can facilitate our entry into new schools.

Zimbabwe: Pray for an economic breakthrough in Zimbabwe as there is a renewed rise in inflation affecting our volunteers and staff financially.

<u>South Africa</u>: Pray for camps that are happening this month.

Malawi: We are having an Area Directors meeting at the end of the month, where we will be praying for the country, the things God has helped us through this year, and the forecast for the rest of the year including camps at the end of July. **Zambia**: We are praying for the Lord to help us fulfill His vision for teens in Zambia.
